An Open Letter to John Boehner, Michael Steele, and the RNC:

We wonder if you still just don't get it.

Where’s the K.I.S.S principle?

Reading the monstrosities the Congress has passed requires a lot of doing, and the more you read and research the more lost liberties you will find. We doubt any member of Congress really knows what they approve.

So, why are bills difficult to understand, other than the fact the number of pages is large, for the average person? Nearly every paragraph or section alters previously passed legislation and refers back to that law. In order to understand what has been altered or added to an old bill, one must go to that previous act, insert the change, then, and only then, will the new addition or change make any sense, if at all.

The “Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act” (HR 4872) is the official short title of the healthcare bill. Here’s the legalese section for the “tax credits” supposed to help offset the required purchase of health insurance by individuals:

SEC. 1001. TAX CREDITS.

(a) **PREMIUM TAX CREDITS.**—Section 36B of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as added by section 1401 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and amended by section 10105 of such Act, is amended—(1) in subsection (b)(3)(A)—(A) in clause (i), by striking “with respect to any taxpayer” and all that follows up to the end period and inserting: “for any taxable year shall be the percentage such that the applicable percentage for any taxpayer whose household income is within an income tier specified in the following table shall increase, on a sliding scale in a linear manner, from the initial premium percentage to the final premium percentage specified in such table for such income tier:

In the case of household income (expressed as a percent of poverty line) within the following income tier:	The initial premium percentage is:	The final premium percentage is:
Up to 133%	2.0%	2.0%
133% up to 150%	3.0%	4.0%
150% up to 200%	4.0%	6.3%
200% up to 250%	6.3%	8.05%
250% up to 300%	8.05%	9.5%
300% up to 400%	9.5%	9.5%

So, if the poverty line, hypothetically, is \$20,000 income per year, a tax credit of \$400 is allowed. Can you buy health insurance for \$400 a year?

Is it any wonder Americans are confused and angry? Speaker Pelosi was correct when she said we’d “find out what’s in the bill after it’s passed.” As a practical matter our representatives don’t write legislation. They or a staffer simply jot down what they want done and turn that over to federal bureaucrats to write the legal language. It’s likely a bill is actually written by a lobbyist or special interest group.

Here’s a section for the employer’s responsibility regarding health insurance?:

“(b) **APPLICABLE PAYMENT AMOUNT.**—Section 4980H of such Code, as so added and amended, is amended—

(1) in the flush text following subsection (c)(1)(B), by striking “400 percent of the applicable payment amount” and inserting “an amount equal to 1/12 of \$3,000”;

(2) in subsection (d)(1), by striking “\$750” and inserting “\$2,000”; and

(3) in subsection (d)(5)(A), in the matter preceding clause (i), by striking “subsection (b)(2) and (d)(1)” and inserting “subsection (b) and paragraph (1)”.

(c) **COUNTING PART-TIME WORKERS IN SETTING THE THRESHOLD FOR EMPLOYER RESPONSIBILITY.**—

Section 4980H(d)(2) of such Code, as so added and amended and as amended by subsection (a), is amended by adding at the end the following new subparagraph:

(E) **FULL-TIME EQUIVALENTS TREATED AS FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES.**—Solely for purposes of determining whether an employer is an applicable large employer under this paragraph, an employer shall, in addition to the number of full-time employees for any month otherwise determined, include for such month a number of full-time employees determined by dividing the aggregate number of hours of service of employees who are not full-time employees for the month by 120”.
